Captain (R) Muhammad Usman Younis is an officer of Pakistan Administrative Service (PAS) from 27thCTP. He has served at various positions including, Chief Commissioner Islamabad, Chairman Capital Development Authority, Commissioner Lahore Division, Secretary, Primary and Secondary Healthcare Department, Punjab, Director General Punjab Food Authority (PFA), District Coordination Officer, Lahore & Rajanpur, Director Food, Punjab. Home Secretary, Gilgit Baltistan and Deputy Commissioner, Gilgit & Astore.



As Chairman Capital Development Authority, he established Pakistan's first Government owned Stray Dogs Population Control Centre (SDPCC) in August 2022. Initiated construction of Bhara Kahu ByPass for easy commute, linked Khayaban-e-Iqbal with Margalla Road. Retrieved more than 4000 Kanals of CDA land from illegal encroachment.

AS Commissioner Lahore, Captain (R) Muhammad Usman launched one of the largest social mobilization campaign "Lahore Wears Masks" with Yale University, Stanford University & LUMS. Campaign got appreciated and replicated in many countries. Supervised COVID-

19vaccination drive and reported daily vaccinated people number at highest throughout country.

Was posted Secretary Primary and Secondary Healthcare, Captain (R) Muhammad Usman during the dengue outbreak of Rawalpindi in 2019 & successfully controlled the outbreak. Headed COVID-19 management team of Punjab. Established 12 state-of-the-art testing labs from scratch in record time of two months, upgraded 12 labs from BSL-II to BSL-III and got accreditation to increase COVID testing capacity of the province from 90 to 18000 tests per day. Arranged training of over 300,000 frontline workers to effectively manage COVID cases in province.

Introduced 32 Standard Operating Procedures for all sectors to manage their working during pandemic.

As Director General Punjab Food Authority, banned loose sale of food items, made MRD (manufacturing and expiry dates) mandatory to be mentioned on all food items, regulated energy drinks to bring down caffeine level from hazardous to tolerable limit, introduced landmark law to control wastage of food and channelized it to poor and needy through hygienic process.

As District Coordination Officer, Lahore, W.H.O. chose DCO Lahore to be polio control ambassador and was requested twice to speak to the participants of national conference at Bhurban, Murree. Strengthened health system and constructed 4 hospitals. Rehabilitated beauty of Lahore by preserving old buildings, regularized services of over 5000 lower staff who were facing service issues for past 20 years to ensure human resource availability for Lahore.

As Director Food, Punjab, Initiated historic negotiations with the banks that resulted in reduction of markup of banks to the extent that Rs. 6 billion were saved each -year. As Home Secretary Gilgit, supervised Atta-Abad Lake incident, ensured safe rehabilitation of population on both sides. Headed the historic Diamer Basha Dam Rehabilitation and Settlement committee.
